ORDINANCE NO. 813

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

Ordinance Section One: Part 3, Chapter 48, Section 020, and Chapter 56, Section 015 of the Sierra County Code are hereby amended in their entirety to read as follows:


Work schedules for regular part-time employees shall be maintained on file with their Department Managers and with the Auditor's Office. Such employees shall only be eligible for sick leave when time off occasioned by sickness occurs on a day for which the regular part-time employee is otherwise scheduled to work. If no work schedule is provided to the Auditor for a regular part-time employee, such employee shall not receive sick leave or vacation credit.

Ordinance Section Two: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance in the Mountain Messenger, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sierra, State of California.




