ORDINANCE NO. 820

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

**Ordinance Section One: NON-CODIFIED FINDINGS AND BACKGROUND**

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA FINDS THAT:

1. The Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office has been authorized to collect parking violation penalties pursuant to Resolution 94-051.
2. The parking penalties, late payment penalties and administrative charges are required to be set by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to Vehicle Code Sec. 40203.5, with the exception of some parking, registration and equipment violation penalties set by State of Federal statute.
3. The parking penalty schedule has been developed to provide uniformity, fairness and ease of administration where it is within the power of the County to do so. Late penalties have been set at a level to recover DMV charges for registration holds and the administrative costs of collecting late payments.
4. All parking penalties include the assessments for the Criminal Justice Facilities Fund and the Courthouse Improvement Fund as required by Resolutions 82-1 and 85-49.

**Ordinance Section Two:** Part 11, Chapter 12, of the Sierra County Code is hereby amended to add Sections 100 through 110 as follows:

**CHAPTER 11.12 - PARKING VIOLATION PENALTIES**

**Sections:**

11.12.100 - Violation of Part 11, Chapter 12

**11.12.100 - Violation of Part 11, Chapter 12**

Violation of Sierra County Code Part 11, Chapter 12 shall be subject to the imposition of a civil penalty in the amount prescribed in this Chapter.

11.12.110 Schedule of Sierra County Parking Violation Penalties

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The Schedule of Sierra County Parking Violation Penalties is as follows:

**Ordinance Section Three:** This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance in the Mountain Messenger, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sierra, State of California.


