ON SMITHNECK ROAD)

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

Ordinance Section One: Part 11, Chapter 08, Section 040 (a) of the Sierra County Code is hereby added to read as follows:

CHAPTER 11.08 - SPEED LIMITS

Sections:

11.08.040 45 Mile Per Hour Speed Zone

11.08.040 45 Mile Per Hour Speed Zone

- (b) The portion of Smithneck Road from M.P. 1.0 for a distance of approximately one mile south to the cattle guard or the end of the pavement on Smithneck Road at the southerly boundary of Sierra Brooks Subdivision, shall have a speed limit of 30 miles per hour during the period of construction commencing from the effective date of this ordinance to October 31, 1994, or upon completion of construction and removal of 30 mph signs, whichever first occurs.

Ordinance Section Two: This ordinance shall automatically sunset and be repealed upon October 31, 1994, or upon completion of construction and removal of 30 mph signs, whichever first occurs.

Ordinance Section Three: This ordinance shall be an urgency ordinance, effective upon adoption, and is necessary for the immediate public protection from unsafe speed during construction work on the roadway on which numerous areas exist at random where asphalt concrete pavement has failed with resultant potholes and severe ravelling of pavement and aggregate base.

Introduced and passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sierra, State of California, held on the 5th day of July, 1994, by the following roll call vote, to-wit:




