ORDINANCE NO. 822

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

**Ordinance Section One:** Part 15, Chapter 34, Sections 010 through 030 of the Sierra County Code is hereby repealed.

**Ordinance Section Two:** Part 17, Chapter 04, Sections 010 through 200 of the Sierra County Code is hereby repealed.

**Ordinance Section Three:** The Sierra County Code is hereby amended to add Part 17, Chapter 04, Sections 010 through 020 as follows:

CHAPTER 17.04 - ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

**17.04.010 CEQA Adopted by Reference.**

The provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") contained in the Public Resources Code, Section 21000 et seq., and the State Environmental Impact Report Guidelines contained in the California Administrative Code, Title 14, Division 6, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq., are hereby adopted by this reference. Any amendments to the applicable provisions of the Public Resources Code and the California Administrative Code shall be applicable.

**17.04.020 Appeals.**

Any decision of the Planning Commission relating to environmental assessments may be appealed to the Board of Supervisors. Determinations of the Planning Commission may be appealed by any person adversely affected by such determinations, provided however, determinations relating to the adequacy of Environmental Impact Reports may only be appealed by the applicant or by persons, organizations, or public agencies who submitted written or oral comments on the record during the public review period or public hearings held by the Planning Commission.


An appeal shall be initiated by filing a written statement with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors within fifteen (15) days following the determination of the Planning Commission. The appeal shall be accompanied by the appropriate fee and shall contain the specific reasons for the appeal.

The appeal shall be governed by the Sierra County Uniform Appeals Procedure (Resolution 90-272, as amended by Resolution 91-210).


**Ordinance Section Four:** This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance in the Mountain Messenger, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sierra, State of California.
