ORDINANCE NO. 825

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:

Ordinance Section One: Part 2, Chapter 04, Section 070 of the Sierra County Code
is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 2.04 - BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Section:

2.04.070 Supervisors' Salaries

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2.04.070.10 Alternative Rates

Salaries of County Supervisors shall be paid either at the "status quo" rate (subsection "a" below) or, at his or her election, at the "increased rate" (subsections "b-1" and "b-2" below).

"Status Quo"

- a) Each supervisor shall receive a salary of \$1025.00 per month, with the exception of the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, whose salary shall be \$1125.00 per month.

"Increased Rate" - fiscal year 94/95

- b-1) Each supervisor shall receive a salary of \$1413.00 per month, with the exception of the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, whose salary shall be \$1513.00 per month commencing on the first pay period after the effective date of this ordinance and continuing through June 30, 1995.

"Increased Rate" - commencing July 1, 1995

- b-2) Each supervisor shall receive a salary of \$1275.00 per month, with the exception of the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, whose salary shall be \$1375.00 per month commencing July 1, 1995 and continuing thereafter until modified by subsequent amendment or repeal of this section.

2.04.070.20 Election of Rate

Within ten days after the effective date of this section, each Supervisor shall provide to the Sierra County Auditor in writing his/her notice of election to receive the "Status Quo" or "Increased Rate" of salary. Any Supervisor who does not notify the Auditor in writing of his or her election within the ten-day period, shall receive a salary at the "Status Quo" salary level - provision 2.04.070.10(a) above.

2.04.070.30 New Supervisor


In the event that new supervisors are seated during the time in which the foregoing section is in effect, each such newly-seated supervisor shall be given the opportunity to select either the "status quo" (Provision 2.04.070.10(a) above) or the "increased rate" (Provision 2.04.070.10(b) above) for a period of ten days after notification in writing from the Auditor's office of the opportunity to make such selection. In the event such Supervisor does not notify the Auditor in writing of his or her election within the ten-day period, such Supervisor shall receive a salary at the "Status Quo" salary level - provision 2.04.070.10(a) above.

Ordinance Section Two: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect sixty (60) days after its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance in the *Mountain Messenger*, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sierra, State of California.


