THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

Ordinance Section One: As an Urgency Ordinance, Part 11, Chapter 06, Section 070 of the Sierra County Code is hereby added to read as follows:

CHAPTER 11.06 - ROAD USE AND MAINTENANCE

11.06.070 Emergency Closure of Lavezzola Road

11.06.070 Emergency Closure of Lavezzola Road

Lavezzola Road shall be closed to all ingress and egress by vehicle and pedestrian traffic, excepting therefrom County and/or other governmental personnel as may be necessary to maintain public health and safety, from the edge of the paved surface of Upper Main Street-Lavezzola Road intersection adjacent to the townsite of Downieville, northerly to the First Divide.

Ordinance Section Two: This ordinance shall be an urgency ordinance, effective upon adoption, and is necessary for the immediate public protection from a landslide which occurred December 17, 1994. The entire road surface is unstable, and poses an immediate risk to life and property to anyone traveling on Lavezzola Road.
