THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:


**Ordinance Section One:** As an Urgency Ordinance, Part 11, Chapter 06, Section 070 of the Sierra County Code is hereby repealed.

**Ordinance Section Two:** This ordinance shall be an urgency ordinance, effective upon adoption, and is necessary for the immediate public protection. Recent temporary repair of Lavezzola Road has made the public and private lands serviced by Lavezzola Road accessible to the public, and emergency reopening of Lavezzola Road is necessary to ensure passage by law enforcement and emergency vehicles, as well as the public.

Introduced and passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sierra, State of California, held on the 5th day of July, 1995, by the following roll call vote, to-wit:


