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ORDINANCE NO. 859

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

Ordinance Section One: Part 8, Chapter 05, Section 010 (1) and Section 040 (1)(A) of the Sierra County Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 8.05 - SOLID WASTE SYSTEM FEES AND CHARGES

8.05.010 Solid Waste System Charges

1. Solid waste system charges are hereby extended and imposed as to all improved real property within Sierra County (unless otherwise exempted due to remote location pursuant to Section 8.05.020 below) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for the use of and/or disposal of refuse through the Sierra County solid waste system. All improved property that uses, or for which the solid waste disposal system is available for their use, shall pay a parcel charge for the 1997-1998 fiscal year, based upon the land use classification and refuse generation factors as established by Sierra County Resolution No. 87-096 and as amended by subsequent resolutions through Resolution No. 96-126. As set forth in the foregoing Resolution No. 96-126, the following land use classifications and respective residential equivalencies are hereby extended.

8.05.040 Gate Fees Established

1. Gate Fees

A. Property Paying Parcel Charges

Any person, firm or entity that brings refuse to the Sierra County landfill or to any County transfer station, the origin of which is from property which has paid a parcel charge pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.05.010, and which refuse is properly source separate as defined in Section 8.04.010 of this Code, shall not pay a gate fee. Property receiving an assessment as "Industrial", pursuant to 8.05.010 shall be allowed to dispose of all wastes generated on such industrial property, which are not otherwise prohibited under this Part without an additional fee, except for processed wood wastes or fly ash. Processed wood wastes or fly ash will be addressed under separate case by case agreements between "industrial" assessees and Sierra County.


Ordinance Section Two: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance in the Mountain Messenger, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sierra, State of California.


