ORDINANCE No. 868

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA EXTENDING THE
SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE IMPOSED ON IMPROVED REAL
PROPERTY WITHIN THE COUNTY FOR THE USE AND/OR ABILITY
TO USE THE SIERRA COUNTY SOLID WASTE SYSTEM FOR THE
1998-1999 FISCAL YEAR**

This Ordinance amends Part 8, Chapter 05 of the Sierra County Code

ORDINANCE SECTION 1.

Part 8 Chapter 05 Sections 010, 020, 120, and 130 of the Sierra County Code are hereby amended as follows:

8.05.010 Solid Waste System Charges

1. Solid waste system charges are hereby extended and imposed as to all improved real property within Sierra County (unless otherwise exempted due to remote location pursuant to Section 8.05.020 below) for the 1998-1999 fiscal year for the use of and/or disposal of refuse through the Sierra County solid waste system. All improved property that uses, or for which the solid waste disposal system is available for their use, shall pay a parcel charge for the 1998-1999 fiscal year, based upon the land use classification and refuse generation factors as established by Sierra County Resolution No. 87-096 and as amended by subsequent resolutions through Resolution No. 96-126. As set forth in the foregoing Resolution No. 96-126 and as amended by this Ordinance, the following land use classifications and respective residential equivalencies are hereby extended.

2. Solid Waste System Charges shall be calculated and imposed based on the rate

of \$76.00 per residential equivalent unit for each land use classification as set out above.

3. The Solid Waste System Charges shall be collected and administered in accordance with the provisions of Resolution Nos. 87-101 and 102.

8.05.020 Exemptions

The following parcels are exempt from the solid waste system improved parcel charges levied pursuant to Section 8.05.010, above:

8.05.120 Parcel Charges for Prior Years

The adoption of the provisions of this ordinance to impose and to extend solid waste charges for the 1998-99 fiscal year and any prior year, shall not be construed to repeal or invalidate the assessment and levy of any such charge for any prior year.

8.05.130 Severability

In any case where a provision of this Chapter is found to be in conflict with a provision of any health ordinance or code enacted by any ordinance-making body within the limits of Sierra County, California, and existing on the effective date of this Chapter, the provisions which establish the higher standard for the promotion and protection of the health of the people shall prevail. In any case where a provision of this Chapter is found to be in conflict with a provision of any other ordinance or code existing within the limits of Sierra County, California, on the effective date of this Chapter which establishes a lower standard for the promotion and protection of the health of the people, the provisions of this Chapter shall be deemed to prevail, and such other ordinance or codes are hereby declared to be repealed to the extent that they may be

found in conflict with this Chapter.

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Chapter should be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Chapter which shall remain in full force and effect; and to this end the provisions of this Chapter are hereby declared to be severable.


ORDINANCE SECTION 2

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage. Before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after passage of this ordinance, it shall be published once with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the ordinance in the Mountain Messenger, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Sierra, State of California.




