Ordinance No. 881

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

Ordinance Section One: As an Urgency Ordinance, Part 7, Chapter 11, Section 020 of the Sierra County Code is hereby added to read as follows:

CHAPTER 11.20.070 - Load Limits

Sections:

11.02.070 Emergency Weight Limit on Fiddle Creek Bridge


The use of Fiddle Creek Bridge, County Bridge Number 13C0021, located .15 miles North of Highway 49 at Indian Valley by any vehicle exceeding a maximum gross weight of six (6) tons is prohibited.

Ordinance Section Two: This ordinance shall be an urgency ordinance, effective upon adoption, and is necessary for the immediate protection of life, personal property and public lands from a structure which has been declared by the State of California, Department of Transportation to be in need of immediate restorative action, and which is vital to the ingress/egress of County and Federal emergency services.




