Ordinance No. 883

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA ORDAINS as follows:

**Ordinance Section One:** As an Urgency Ordinance, Part 11, Chapter 20, Section 080 of the Sierra County Code is hereby added to read as follows:

CHAPTER 11.20.080 - Load Limits

Sections:

**11.20.080 Emergency Weight Limit on Goodyears Creek Bridge**

The use of Goodyears Creek Bridge, County Bridge Number 13C0022, located .6 miles North of State Route 49 at Goodyears Bar by any vehicle exceeding a maximum gross weight of six (6) tons is prohibited.

**Ordinance Section Two:** This ordinance shall be an urgency ordinance, effective upon adoption, and is necessary for the immediate protection of life, personal property and public lands from a structure which has been declared by Director of Transportation of the County of Sierra to be unsafe for use by vehicles in excess of 6 tons and in need of immediate restorative action, and which is vital to the ingress/egress of County and Federal emergency services.

Introduced and passed and adopted at a regular meeting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sierra, State of California, held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March 1999, by the following roll call vote, to wit:


