

ORDINANCE NO. 742

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS,
COUNTY OF SIERRA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 3.16 RELATING TO EMERGENCY
AND EXTRA HELP HIRING

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Sierra, State of California, does ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 3.16, Section 3.16.020 of the Sierra County Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"Section 3.16.020 Emergency and Extra Help Hiring.

The procedures in this part need not be followed if an emergency occurs which, in the opinion of the appointing authority, requires the filling of a job vacancy. Such emergency appointment for a permanent position for which the Board of Supervisors has budgeted and authorized the department head, or appointing authority, to maintain such job classification in the department, shall be effective for only 60 days or upon completion of the normal hiring procedures, whichever occurs first. No extension of an emergency appointment may be granted under this Section. In the event that an emergency appointment is made for nonauthorized position, that emergency appointment shall be good only until the next regular or special meeting of the Board of Supervisors. At that time the appointment shall terminate unless the Board of Supervisors authorizes the continued filling of the emergency appointment.

classification.

The hiring of extra help personnel shall be made only from eligibility lists maintained pursuant to this Chapter, except that if the list for a particular position is not current an emergency hire may be made for a period not to exceed ten (10) days or until the next regular or special meeting of the Board of Supervisors, whichever comes first. In no case shall the employment of any extra help employee exceed one hundred and twenty (120) days or 960 hours, whichever is less, in any single classification in any one fiscal year. SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is declared to be an urgency measure for the preservation of the public health and safety in accordance with the provisions of the Government Code of the State of California and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 3. PUBLICATION

This ordinance shall become effective and in full force and effect upon the adoption thereof, and prior to fifteen days from the passage thereof, shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation, published and printed in the County of Sierra, State of California, together with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against same.


