ORDINANCE NO. 749

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SIERRA DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: Sierra County Code, Section 11.06.060 is
added as follows:

11.06.060 THE PORT WINE RIDGE ROAD (COUNTY ROAD 690)
IS HEREBY CLOSED TO ALL THROUGH TRAFFIC due to severe
damage and failure to the road at the approximate
location of Gardners Point Mine.

Section Two: This ordinance is an urgency ordinance for
the protection of the public and the users of Port Wine
Ridge Road (County Road 690) and is necessary for the
protection of the public health, safety, and welfare due to
the dangerous conditions created by the damage and failure
of the road.




